We have many new or soon-to-be teen drivers at Foundations School!

Traffic crashes are the leading cause of teen fatalities, accounting for 44% of teen deaths in the U.S.

Young drivers are involved in fatal crashes at more than twice the rate of all others.

The first year for a newly licensed teenage driver is the most dangerous, with more than one in five involved in crashes.

Each year nearly 6,000 teens are killed in vehicular accidents; more than 3,800 are drivers aged 15-20

What happens during Alive At 25 Courses?

Our DDC-Alive at 25 instructors use personal examples and even humor to get their point across.

They use workbook exercises, interactive media segments, group discussions, role-playing, and short lectures to help young drivers develop convictions and strategies that will keep them safer on the road.

DDC-Alive at 25 teaches young adults that: People in their age group are more likely to be hurt or killed in a vehicle crash.
